Proposed Charter Amendment the Village of New Lebanon

Shall SECTION 3.01 QUALIFICATIONS, be amended to read as follows: "The Mayor shall be a qualified elector of the Municipality, and shall have been, prior to the date of filing a declaration of candidacy, a continuous resident of the Municipality or any territory annexed thereto, for one (1) year, and any Mayoral qualifying electorate shall be in good standing on all New Lebanon Municipal income taxes prior to filing a declaration of candidacy. During their term of Office, they shall continue to be a resident, a qualified elector, and must remain in good standing on all Municipal income taxes throughout their elected term. If the Mayor shall cease to possess any of the qualifications for such office, they shall forthwith forfeit his office."
