Shall SECTION 7.03 QUALIFICATIONS OF ELECTED OFFICERS be amended to read as follows: "Each elected officer of the Municipality shall be a qualified elector of the Municipality, and shall have been, prior to date of filing a declaration of candidacy, a continuous resident of the Municipality or territory annexed thereto, for one (1) year, and any qualifying electorate shall be in good standing on all New Lebanon Municipal income taxes prior to nomination for such office and shall remain in good standing on all Municipal income taxes throughout their elected term of office. No elected officer shall be an employee of the Municipality. If an elected officer shall cease to possess any of the qualifications for such office, they shall forthwith forfeit his office. " ?
