## ORDINANCE 2021-12 BY MAYOR RAYMOND ARRIOLA

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING §73.03 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF NEW LEBANON.

WHEREAS, §73.03 of the Code of Ordinances of the Municipality of New Lebanon which reads as follows:

## § 73.03 PROHIBITED STANDING OR PARKING PLACES.

No person shall stand or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or to comply with the provisions of this Title, or while obeying the directions of a police officer or a traffic-control device, in any of the following places:

- (A) On a sidewalk, except a bicycle;
- (B) In front of a public or private driveway;
- (C) Within an intersection;
- (D) Within 10 feet of a fire hydrant;
- (E) On a crosswalk;
- (F) Within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection;
- (G) Within 30 feet of, and upon the approach to, any flashing beacon, stop sign, or traffic-control device;
- (H) Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within 30 feet of points on the curb immediately opposite the end of a safety zone, unless a different length is indicated by a traffic-control device;
  - (I) Within 50 feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing;
- (J) Within 20 feet of a driveway entrance to any fire station and on the side of the street opposite the entrance to any fire station, within 75 feet of the entrance when it is properly posted with signs;
- (K) Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when such standing or parking would obstruct traffic;
  - (L) Alongside any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street;
  - (M) On any bridge or other elevated structure on a highway, or within a highway tunnel;
- (N) At any place where signs prohibit stopping, standing, or parking, or where the curbing is painted yellow, or at any place in excess of the maximum time limited by signs;
  - (0) Within one foot of another parked vehicle;
  - (P) On the roadway portion of a freeway, expressway, or thruway.
  - (Q) In any fire lane when so marked as such.
- (R) At any place in time of public necessity for periods not to exceed 72 hours, where signs prohibiting parking have been erected by order of the Chief of Police.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Municipality of New Lebanon, Ohio, that §73.03 IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ

§ 73.03 PROHIBITED STANDING OR PARKING PLACES.

No person shall stand or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or to comply with the provisions of this Title, or while obeying the directions of a police officer or a traffic-control device, in any of the following places:

- (A) On a sidewalk, curb, or street lawn area between a curb and right-of-way line
- (B) Over a curb, between the outside edge of a shoulder and the sidewalk, between the outside edge of a roadway that has no shoulder and the sidewalk;
- (C) In front of a public or private driveway. In front of shall include the area within five feet of the driveway width projected to the curb line or roadway edge, or the point along the curb or roadway edge where the driveway intersects, whichever is greater;
  - (D) Within an intersection;
  - (E) Within 10 feet of a fire hydrant;
  - (F) On a crosswalk;
- (G) Within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection, or, if there is no crosswalk, within 20 feet of an intersection;
- (H) Within 30 feet of, and upon the approach to, any flashing beacon, stop sign, or traffic-control device;
- (I) Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within 30 feet of points on the curb immediately opposite the end of a safety zone, unless a different length is indicated by a traffic-control device;
  - (J) Within 50 feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing;
- (K) Within 20 feet of a driveway entrance to any fire station and on the side of the street opposite the entrance to any fire station, within 75 feet of the entrance when it is properly posted with signs;
- (L) Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when such standing or parking would obstruct traffic;
  - (M) Alongside any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street;
  - (N) On any bridge or other elevated structure on a highway, or within a highway tunnel;
- (0) At any place where signs prohibit stopping, standing, or parking, or where the curbing is painted yellow, or at any place in excess of the maximum time limited by signs;
  - (P) Within one foot of another parked vehicle;
  - (Q) On the roadway portion of a freeway, expressway, or thruway.
  - (R) In any fire lane when so marked as such.
  - (S) Upon a street or alley 23 feet or less;
  - (T) Upon any traffic control island or median that separates traffic on a street;
  - (U) Within 10 feet of the junction of an alley and a street;
- (V) At any place in time of public necessity for periods not to exceed 72 hours, where signs prohibiting parking have been erected by order of the Chief of Police.

**SECTION 1:** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period by law.
