A RESOLUTION DECLARING PROPERTY AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER TO DONATE IT TO SINCLAIR COMMUNITY COLLEGE FIRE SCIENCE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of New Lebanon is in possession of surplus properties from the Fire Department that is currently of no use to the Municipality, and

WHEREAS, the old engine does not run, and

WHEREAS, Sutphen and Heritage have offered to work with Sinclair on the cost to get the engine usable for Sinclair, and

WHEREAS, The engine would not be impacted by the water tank leaking like it does in the emergency environment of our fire department, and

WHEREAS, Many of the firefighters employed by the Village or have been employed in the past have received their initial training at Sinclair, and

WHEREAS, This is a way to support a program that has a direct impact on our future employees and community, and

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Municipality of New Lebanon, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That specific property includes a 1992 Pierce Arrow Pumper Truck Vehicle ID E-6948 Chassis VIN 4P1CA02DXNA000350.

SECTION 2: That the Municipal Manager is hereby authorized to donate the surplus property/vehicle to Sinclair Community College Fire Science Department.

SECTION 3: The effective date of this Resolution shall be from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
