

ORDINANCE 2022-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 5(A)(3) AND (4), 7, 10, 11, 14, AND 20 OF APPENDIX: RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF NEW LEBANON.

WHEREAS, Sections 5(A)(3) and (4), 7, 10, 11, 14, AND 20 of Appendix: Rules and Regulations of the Code of Ordinances of the Municipality of New Lebanon reads as follows:

§ 5. WATER CONNECTIONS.

(A) All water connections hereafter constructed or relayed from the water main to the meter box shall be of the following specified material:

(3) All service pipes required larger than 1½" size shall be ductile iron pipe from the main to the meter box.

(4) All so-called meter boxes installed or reset must be placed as near main and property line as feasible.

§ 7. INSPECTION SERVICES.

The plumber doing service work between the main and the meter box must have the work inspected before it is covered up, and must notify the Service Department in time for said inspection.

§ 10. INDEPENDENT SERVICE FOR EACH PROPERTY.

No single service shall serve more than one meter except in special cases which must be approved by the Village.

§ 11. STOPS AT METER LOOP.

All water services must have a stop on both sides of the meter so that the meter may be removed without draining pipes in the building. A curb stop shall be installed on the main side of the meter loop.

§ 14. SERVICE TO BE DISCONTINUED.

Any property owner wishing to have his water service discontinued shall notify the Municipal Office. The regular rate will be charged until such notice is given and must be paid before the service is again turned on.

§ 20. METERS DAMAGED OR STOLEN.

If a meter on the premises is stolen, damaged by freezing, fire or hot water, or is damaged in any other way due to the act or neglect of the consumer or property owner, the cost of repairs or replacement shall be paid by the property owner. If the meter seal is found broken or other proof of tampering with the meter is found, the bill for the period in question will be estimated and the service may be shut off until all just charges are paid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Municipality of New Lebanon, Ohio, that **Sections 5(A)(3) and (4), 7, 10, 11, 14, AND 20 of Appendix: Rules and Regulations** of the Code of Ordinances of the Municipality of New Lebanon **IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ:**

§ 5. WATER CONNECTIONS.

(A) All water connections hereafter constructed or relayed from the water main to the meter box shall be of the following specified material:

(3) All service pipes required larger than 1.5" size shall be type K copper or plastic (cts) rated at 200 psi from the main to the meter box.

(4) All so-called meter boxes installed or reset must be placed as near to the back of sidewalk and property line as feasible.

§ 7. INSPECTION SERVICES.

The plumber doing service work between the main and the meter box must have the work inspected before it is covered up and must notify the Service Department in time for said inspection. New installations or replacements must be inspected by the Combined Health District (Montgomery County).

§ 10. INDEPENDENT SERVICE FOR EACH PROPERTY.

No single service shall serve more than one meter without exception.

§ 11. STOPS AT METER LOOP.

All water services must have an angle stop on both sides of the meter so that the meter may be removed without draining pipes in the building.

§ 14. SERVICE TO BE DISCONTINUED.

Any property owner wishing to have his water service discontinued shall notify the Municipal Office. The regular rate will be charged during regular operating hours. Emergency after hours rates will apply for after hour requests and must be paid before the service is again turned on.

§ 20. METERS DAMAGED OR STOLEN.

If a meter on the premises is stolen, damaged by freezing, fire or hot water, or is damaged in any other way due to the act or neglect of the consumer or property owner, the cost of repairs or replacement shall be paid by the property owner. If the meter seal is found broken or other proof of tampering with the meter is found, the bill for the period in question will be estimated, a tampering fee will be charged, and the service may be shut off until all just charges are paid.

SECTION 1: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period by law.




