## RESOLUTION 2023-13 BY MAYOR RAYMOND ARRIOLA

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI VALLEY LIGHTING, LLC AN OHIO LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY AND SUBSIDIARY OF DPL, INC. ("MVLT") FOR STREET LIGHTING AND OTHER ENERGY RELATED SERVICES ON PUBLIC GROUNDS, FACILITIES AND STREETS IN THE VILLAGE OF NEW LEBANON, STATE OF OHIO FOR A TERM BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2024 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2028.

**WHEREAS,** the current Mayor, Municipal Council and Administration are continually searching for opportunities to reduce taxes, assessments, and other financial burdens on New Lebanon's residents, businesses, and property owners; and

**WHEREAS**, the lighting of roadways and neighborhoods enhances public safety and security;

**WHEREAS,** Miami Valley Lighting, LLC changed-out approximately 335 HPS and 6MV cobra head street lights to LED in 2019-2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the monthly full service charge of the LED saved New Lebanon an estimated \$ 14,838.00 over the last four (4) years.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** Be is Resolved by the Council of the Municipality of New Lebanon, Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** The Municipal Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and enter into a contract with Miami Valley Lighting, LLC an Ohio Limited Liability Company and Subsidiary of DPL, INC. ("MVLT") for street lighting services, including exclusive energy consulting and electric energy supply for the five (5) years of said agreement; and

**SECTION 2.** The effective date of this Resolution shall be from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
